




















Mel has started as our cleaner & is loving it!



A new Aged Care Act Fact sheet for older people

The aged care system is changing, and we want to hear from you.



The Department of Health and Aged Care (the department) is developing a new Aged Care Act that

will put the rights of older people at the centre of our aged care system.

The new Act will follow the journey of older people in the system and prioritise their needs. It will clearly set out the responsibilities of aged care providers and protect the rights of older people to safe, quality care.



What's changing?

The Royal Commission into Aged Care Quality and Safety found that the current Aged Care Act is no longer fit for purpose.

The new Act will:

- create a simple, single-entry point to make access to the aged care system for older people easier
- include a fair, culturally safe single assessment process
- include rules on supported decisionmaking to ensure older people have choice and control
- provide additional protections for whistle-blowers to allow reporting without fear of reprisal
- introduce a new approach to regulating aged care providers to ensure delivery of safe, quality aged care services
- strengthen the powers of the regulator, the Aged Care Quality and Safety Commission, to manage risk, ensure integrity and support aged care.

When will the new Act start?

Subject to being passed in Parliament, the new Act is planned to start on 1 July 2024.

Consultation

The draft of the new Act (called the exposure draft) is now available for public consultation. The department is seeking input and feedback from older people, their families and carers. Your feedback will help to shape the new Act before it is introduced in Parliament in 2024. Consultation will close on Friday 16 February 2024. You can contribute to consultation on the new Act by:

- attending a workshop and talking to the department directly about what is important to you







Fruits Crossword









